ACARTS November 2019 Board Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Dave, W9LKH.

Dave announced the November meeting would be the Hamfest Wrap-up and the club elections, and that December would be the Christmas Dinner at 6:00 p.m. on the 17th at Hall's Guesthouse.

Dave asked about a program for the January meeting and asked if we should hold a February meeting as there is no SKYWARN training in February this year.

Pending the results of the Hamfest, the possibility of discontinuing the Hamfest and even disbanding ACARTS, because of lack of participation and attendance at functions and meetings was discussed. It was decided that we would get the general feeling of the membership at the November meeting and decide how to proceed.

Dave announced that the intermittent 146.88 repeater antenna on the WANE-TV tower had been replaced by the tower crew that changing antennas for WANE-TV's move from channel 31 to channel 32. The new antenna made a noticeable improvement.

Dave said that some of the board members had received e-mails allegedly from him that were a scam attempt. He said that the style and signature were obviously not his and to ignore anything like them in the future.

Dave stated that nominations were open and asked the board members present would run for another term. Bernie, K9JDF, said the he did not want to run for another term as a Board Member at Large. Dave asked those present to, while talking to members at the Hamfest, encourage them to run for office and get involved.

Joseph, K9RFZ, gave an update on the status of the Hamfest preparations, stated that the workers' packages had been mailed the previous Saturday, and that he had 28 reservations for the Hamfest Banquet.

No other business was discussed.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.

Dave passed out the ballots and asked for any additional nominations from the floor. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to accept the list of candidates as presented by acclamation. A motion was made by Bernie, K9JDF, seconded by Steve, K9SKS, and passed by a voice vote.

Dave thanked everyone of attending and participating in the meeting and stated that the level of enthusiasm must be maintained through the year to make the club continue to be successful.
